**Minister Kazim Hosein calls on the public to identify and report derelict vehicles and dilapidated buildings**

*March 8<sup>th</sup>, 2017 Kent House, Maraval* – On Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> March, 2017 the National Clean-Up Campaign will make its way to the Penal/Debe region with a launch ceremony at the Francis Seupaul Recreation Ground (Opposite Namdevco Southern Market) at 8:00am.
