Minister Hosein grants approval for \$1 Million Dollars to ALL Municipal Corporations for COVID-19 measures

April 23rd, 2020. Kent House, Maraval – The Minister of Rural Development and Local Government, Senator the Honourable Kazim Hosein, has granted the necessary approval to allow Corporations to utilize a maximum of one million (\$1Mn) dollars from their “Unspent Balances”, in light of the COVID-19 pandemic. This is in accordance with Section 112 (2) of the Municipal Corporations Act, Chapter 25:04.

Pursuant to the Honourable Prime Minister’s directive to ALL Corporations to utilize their unspent balances to implement measures to stem the spread of COVID-19, the Ministry of Rural Development and Local Government has been working closely with the Municipal Corporations to ensure that the necessary procedures are followed and requests for utilization of unspent balances are urgently processed.

Most recently, on Monday 20th April 2020, Minister Hosein hosted a virtual meeting with all Mayors and Chairmen to discuss the use of 1 million dollars from their unspent balances as of September 2019, to assist Corporations in providing critical services such as water trucking, more frequent public sanitization exercises, additional personal protective equipment (PPE) to staff and humanitarian aid to burgesses. He emphasized, “These are very difficult times that we are facing and we must be our brother’s keeper in this fight against the Novel Coronavirus. The only way we can win this fight is to work together and put our burgesses first. With the approval to use up to 1 million dollars, each Corporation will be better able to help those in need in their regions, boroughs and cities.”

Senator Hosein further commended the ongoing efforts of the Corporations saying, “I would like to thank all the employees of the 14 Municipal Corporations and those at the Ministry for continuing to work together to ensure that our communities, and by extension our country, remain clean during this crisis. To all the public health, sanitation workers, the very hardworking garbage collectors, our dedicated Municipal Police Officers and all frontline workers, we commend you for the unreserved efforts demonstrated across all municipalities.”
