#### Minister Kazim Hosein Prioritizes Citizens' Safety for Carnival

Minister Hosein wishes all citizens a happy and safe Carnival but notes that not all citizens participate in Carnival activities. In fact, many persons; church and other religious groups choose get away from the hustle and bustle of the city to enjoy the long weekend at the beach and spend quality time with their families and friends. Minister Hosein remarked, "We have recently increased the Trinidad and Tobago Municipal Police Service and another batch will be graduating in July. With these increases in the numbers of constables, we aim to have greater interaction between the Municipal Police and the community."

With that spirit in mind, Minister Hosein and the Municipal Police Service have collaborated with the Trinidad and Tobago Police Service (TTPS) to maintain a stronger police presence at all major beaches and rivers from **Carnival Friday until Ash Wednesday**. Chairman of the San Juan/Laventille Regional Corporation Anthony Roberts, commended Minister Hosein on his consistent effort to assist citizens through various programmes and pledged his Corporation's full support for maintaining the safety of citizens at this time.

As the Minister toured the newly refurbished Maracas Bay, many citizens extended their hands in thanks as they greeted him.
